Thank you for your interest in the Intermediate pet dog training course.

Now that you have the basics in place, such as sit, down, wait, stay, coming back when called etc, we can progress each command by putting them into various exercises that will help to strengthen each command and just how quickly your dogs' are responding to you.

The idea of the Intermediate course is to continue what some of you have already learnt in the Novice Classes, but in a more intense environment. This is not to say it will create stress, but there will be more distraction, and more group exercises

The Intermediate Course will cover various exercises that will enable you to gain or regain control of your dog whilst off lead. The beauty of the class environment is that your dog has nowhere to go, therefore the frustration is kept to a minimum and your dog is more likely to respond to you, allowing the level of your relationship to grow further.

We will cover the following, plus much more:

- Back command
- Door/Gate Manners
- Direction Control
- Distance Control
- Food Control
- Toy Distraction
- Wait and Stay

All of the above will be carried out off lead where possible. Every step will be taken to ensure that your dogs' work to their full potential with the use of food/toy reward, motivation and praise.

It is important to remember that although you may feel your dog isn't yet ready, without putting them in these situations, they never will be. You are able to continue the Novice training at home and on walks, but to put into practice what has already been taught, and using different scenarios will only aid your dogs progress, therefore it is best to strike whilst the iron is hot!

Remember high-value tasty treats get better results! If your dog isn't food motivated please bring along a favourite toy or two.

It is vital that you remain consistent. If you haven't carried out any training with your dog for a while, they may have come out of the habit of doing as they are asked. It is advisable that you put in a fair amount of effort; this will aid the weeks ahead and re-affirm your relationship with your dog.
